
## Edit Module and Group Names

### Abstract

- This help file will illustrate how create custom menu names.

### Procedure

1. Navigate to "Content Management" and then select "Manage Left Menu Names" from the drop down menu. The resulting page allows the user to rename modules and groups. Clicking on the +/- box to the left of the group names will expand/contract the view so that all items in the group can be seen or hidden as desired.

<input type="text" value="Activant Catalog Demo"/>	Browse our catalog through make, model and category so that you can find the parts appropriate for your vehicle
<input type="text" value="Brand Search"/>	Express catalog is for searching the catalog through brands. Thus you need to choose brands you prefer
<input type="text" value="Keyword Search *"/>	Keyword Search allows you to search parts by just providing a description or name of part you are searching for
<input type="text" value="Last Ten Lookups *"/>	Last Ten Lookups give you your last 10 lookups of the vehicle, so you donot need to choose the year, make, model all the time for your vehicles
<input type="text" value="Specialty Import"/>	Custom catalog contains parts that are not available through ePartExpert
<input type="text" value="Search Catalog"/>	Search Catalog by selecting all make, model, year and categories on single page with parts
<input type="text" value="Upload Stock Order"/>	Bulk Order is for order in bulk. The order should be in the prescribed Excel format
<input type="text" value="Allow Place Order *"/>	Allow Place Order
<input type="text" value="Multi Category Search"/>	Multi Category Search
<input type="text" value="Create Estimate"/>	Create Estimate
<input type="text" value="Speed Catalog"/>	Speed Catalog
